# Our daily Lectio

## Monthly Calendar of Gestures

1. We are **punctual** for praying the Hours in community.
2. We enter the chapel in **procession**.
3. We come to pray the Liturgy of the Hours in **habit**.
4. We make a **profound bow** before the Blessed Sacrament.
5. We listen to a brief **musical prelude** before beginning.
6. We **enthron**e the Bible or the Book of Gospels.
7. We light **candles** during Morning Prayer and Evening Prayer.
8. We light the **Paschal Candle**.
9. We adorn the chapel with **flowers**.
10. We have a moment of **silence** before beginning our prayer.
11. We sing the **hymn**.
12. We read aloud the patristic **quotation** before each psalm.
13. We use the quotation from the Fathers as an **antiphon**.
14. One of the psalms is recited by **only one person**.
15. We recite as **one continuous psalm** one that is divided into parts.
16. We make a **reflective pause** between one psalm and another.
17. We add an **Augustinian commentary** to each psalm.
18. We use well prepared **psalm prayers**.
19. We sing the scriptural **canticle**.
20. We **bow** at the *Glory to the Father*.
21. We take a moment to **reflect** after the short reading.
22. We proclaim the short reading from the **lectern**.
23. We take turn in praying the **intercessions**.
24. We add **spontaneous** or prepared intercessions.
25. We sing or recite the *Our Father* in **Latin**.
26. We **extend our hands** as we pray the *Our Father*.
27. We pray the Lauds or Vespers before the **Sacrament exposed**.
28. We light a few grains of **incense**.
29. We pray Morning Prayer or Evening Prayer with the **faithful**.
30. We read the **Martyrology** during Lauds or Vespers.
31. The presider **steps forward** to give the blessing.
